An act to add Section 12814.1 to the Vehicle Code, relating to vehicles.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 966, as introduced, Krekorian. Driver's license renewal: senior citizens.

Existing law allows a person 62 years of age or older to be issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles, free of a charge, an identification card bearing the notation "Senior Citizen."

This bill would require the department to include with a notice of renewal of a driver's license that is mailed to a person who is 62 years of age or older, an informational statement that the person may be issued, free of charge, an identification card bearing the notation "Senior Citizen."

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: yes.  
State-mandated local program: no.
