An act to amend Section 17022 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, relating to taxation.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1592, as introduced, Huff. Personal income taxes.

The Personal Income Tax Law imposes taxes on income and provides definitions of specified terms for purposes of that law.

This bill would make technical, nonsubstantive changes to those provisions.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 17022 of the Revenue and Taxation Code
