An act to amend Section 13355 of the Vehicle Code, relating to vehicles.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2669, as introduced, Krekorian. Speeding: minors.

Existing law requires the Department of Motor Vehicles to immediately suspend the privilege of any person to operate a motor vehicle for a specified period of time and subject to certain restrictions upon receipt of a duly certified abstract of the record of any court showing that the person has been convicted of a speeding violation at a speed greater than 100 miles per hour or upon a receipt of a report of a judge of a juvenile court, a juvenile hearing officer, or a referee of a juvenile court showing the same as to a person under the age of 21.

This bill would make a technical, nonsubstantive change to these provisions.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 13355 of the Vehicle Code is amended

3 13355. The department shall immediately suspend the privilege
4 of ~~any~~ a person to operate a motor vehicle upon receipt of a duly
5 certified abstract of the record of ~~any~~ a court showing that the

1 person has been convicted of a violation of subdivision (b) of
2 Section 22348, or upon a receipt of a report of a judge of a juvenile
3 court, a juvenile hearing officer, or a referee of a juvenile court
4 showing that the person has been found to have committed a
5 violation of subdivision (b) of Section 22348 under the following
6 conditions and for the periods, as follows:

7 (a) Upon a conviction or finding of an offense under subdivision
8 (b) of Section 22348 that occurred within three years of a prior
9 offense resulting in a conviction of an offense under subdivision
10 (b) of Section 22348, the privilege shall be suspended for a period
11 of six months, or the privilege shall be restricted for six months
12 to necessary travel to and from the person's place of employment
13 and, if driving a motor vehicle is necessary to perform the duties
14 of the person's employment, restricted to driving within the
15 person's scope of employment.

16 (b) Upon a conviction or finding of an offense under subdivision
17 (b) of Section 22348 that occurred within five years of two or more
18 prior offenses resulting in convictions of offenses under subdivision
19 (b) of Section 22348, the privilege shall be suspended for a period
20 of one year, or the privilege shall be restricted for one year to
21 necessary travel to and from the person's place of employment
22 and, if driving a motor vehicle is necessary to perform the duties
23 of the person's employment, restricted to driving within the
24 person's scope of employment.
