An act to amend Section 3206 of the Elections Code, relating to voting.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2796, as introduced, Furutani. Elections: vote by mail.

Under existing law, a voter whose name appears on the vote by mail voter list is mailed a vote by mail ballot for each election conducted within his or her precinct in which he or she is eligible to vote.

This bill would make nonsubstantive changes to this provision.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no.

State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 3206 of the Elections Code is amended
2 to read:

3 3206. A voter whose name appears on the permanent vote by
4 mail voter list shall remain on the list and ~~shall~~ be mailed a vote
5 by mail ballot for each election conducted within his or her precinct
6 in which ~~he or she~~ *that voter* is eligible to vote. If the voter fails
7 to return an executed vote by mail ballot in two consecutive
8 statewide general elections in accordance with Section 3017, the
9 voter's name shall be deleted from the list.
