Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 69—Relative to Joint Rule 36.9.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SCR 69, as introduced, Denham. Budget Bill votes.

This measure would add a provision to the Joint Rules of the Senate and Assembly for the 2007–08 Regular Session to require that a vote by a committee or subcommittee in either house of the Legislature to take action on the Budget Bill, or a vote by a conference committee to take action on the Budget Bill, be a $\frac{2}{3}$ vote.
