An act to amend Section 14600 of the Government Code, relating to the Department of General Services.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 398, as introduced, Denham. State government: Department of General Services.

Existing law provide for the Department of General Services in state government with specified powers and duties.

This bill would make technical, nonsubstantive changes to this provision.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

*The people of the State of California do enact as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 14600 of the Government Code is  
2 amended to read:  
3 14600. The Legislature declares that *a the* centralization of  
4 business management functions and services of state government  
5 is necessary *and desirable* to take advantage of specialized  
6 techniques and skills, provide uniform management practices, and  
7 to insure a continuing high level of efficiency and economy. A  
8 Department of General Services is created to provide centralized  
9 services including, but not limited to, planning, acquisition,  
10 construction, *inventory*, and maintenance of state buildings and  
11 property; purchasing; printing; architectural services; administrative  
12 hearings; and accounting services. ~~The Department of General~~

1 ~~Services~~ *department* shall develop and enforce policy and  
2 procedures and shall institute or cause the institution of those  
3 investigations and proceedings as it deems proper to assure  
4 effective operation of all functions performed by the department  
5 and to conserve the rights and interests of the state.
