LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 626, as introduced, Harman. Sex offenders.

Existing law requires a person convicted of any specified sex offense to register as a sex offender.

This bill would declare the Legislature's intent to enact legislation to require every sex offender to supply proof of his or her current residence to local law enforcement.
