An act relating to child care.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 635, as introduced, Margett. Child care: CalWORKs recipients: fraud.

The Child Care and Development Services Act requires that child care be provided in various stages to recipients of benefits under the California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids (CalWORKs) program.

This bill would declare the intent of the Legislature to enact legislation to establish best practices for the prevention, detection, identification, and investigation of fraud committed by recipients of stage 2 and stage 3 child care services pursuant to the CalWORKs program.
