An act relating to infrastructure.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 977, as introduced, Correa. Infrastructure: seniors.

Under existing law, various bond acts have been approved by the voters of the state to provide funds for specified infrastructure and public works projects, programs, and facilities relating to transportation, housing, and disaster relief.

This bill would declare the intent of the Legislature to enact legislation that would require the preparation of a statewide study to determine the current and future infrastructure needs created by increases in the numbers of elderly persons in the state.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no.
State-mandated local program: no.
