LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL’S DIGEST

SB 1742, as introduced, Oropeza. Women’s rights.

Existing law, the Unruh Civil Rights Act, prohibits discrimination on the basis of, among other characteristics, gender.

This bill would express the intent of the Legislature to enact legislation addressing women’s equal rights.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. It is the intent of the Legislature to enact
- 2 legislation addressing women’s equal rights.
