An act to add Section 89013 to the Education Code, relating to the California State University.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 24, as introduced, Block. California State University: feasibility study: Chula Vista.

Existing law establishes the various segments of the public higher education system in the state. These segments include the University of California, which is administered by the Regents of the University of California, the California State University, which is administered by the Trustees of the California State University, and the California Community Colleges, which is administered by the Board of Governors of the California Community Colleges.

This bill would require the Trustees of the California State University by January 1, 2011, to conduct a study about the feasibility of a California State University satellite program, and ultimately, an independent California State University campus, at Chula Vista.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: yes. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 89013 is added to the Education Code,
- 2 to read:

1 89013. The Trustees of the California State University shall
2 by January 1, 2011, conduct a study about the feasibility of a
3 California State University satellite program, and ultimately, an
4 independent California State University campus, at Chula Vista.
5 The study shall include a projection of student demand, regional
6 workforce needs, prospective economic impact and job creation
7 in the region, infrastructure availability, and the potential
8 alleviation of overcrowding and traffic at the California State
9 University San Diego campus.
