Assembly Concurrent Resolution No. 12—Relative to the National Purple Heart Trail.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

ACR 12, as introduced, Blakeslee. National Purple Heart Trail.

This measure would designate State Highway Route 101 from the City of San Luis Obispo to San Ardo for inclusion in the National Purple Heart Trail. The measure would also request that the Department of Transportation determine the cost for appropriate signs showing this special designation and, upon receiving donations from nonstate sources covering that cost, erect those signs.

Fiscal committee: yes.

- 1 WHEREAS, The National Purple Heart Trail was established
2 in 1992 for the purpose of commemorating and honoring men and
3 women who have been wounded or killed in combat while serving
4 in the United States Armed Forces; and
5 WHEREAS, The National Purple Heart Trail courses its way
6 across the vast majority of the United States; and
7 WHEREAS, In 2001, pursuant to Senate Concurrent Resolution
8 14, the Legislature designated portions of State Highway Routes
9 5 and 80 as California's selections for inclusion in the National
10 Purple Heart Trail; and
11 WHEREAS, The Legislature finds that it is appropriate to
12 designate additional portions of the state highway system for

1 inclusion in the National Purple Heart Trail in order to honor the
2 men and women who have been wounded or killed in combat while
3 serving in the United States Armed Forces; now therefore, be it

4 *Resolved by the Assembly of the State of California, the Senate*
5 *thereof concurring*, That the Legislature hereby designates the
6 portion of State Highway Route 101 from the City of San Luis
7 Obispo to San Ardo for inclusion in the National Purple Heart
8 Trail; and be it further

9 *Resolved*, That the Department of Transportation is requested
10 to determine the cost of appropriate signs, consistent with the
11 signing requirements for the state highway system, showing that
12 special designation and, upon receiving donations from nonstate
13 sources covering that cost, to erect those signs; and be it further

14 *Resolved*, That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly transmit copies
15 of this resolution to the Department of Transportation and to the
16 author for appropriate distribution.
