Assembly Concurrent Resolution No. 27—Relative to World Languages and Cultures Month.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

ACR 27, as introduced, Davis. Language education: World Languages and Cultures Month.

This measure would declare the month of May 2009 as World Languages and Cultures Month.

1 WHEREAS, On January 7, 2009, the State Board of Education 2 approved the content standards for teaching foreign languages in 3 kindergarten and grades 1 to 12, inclusive, which will strengthen 4 the teaching of languages and cultures to pupils in California; and WHEREAS, California language organizations are participating 5 in a 10-year Discover Languages, Discover the World! campaign 6 sponsored by the American Council on the Teaching of Foreign 7 8 Languages to increase public awareness in the United States of the importance of providing educational instruction in languages 9 10 and cultures: and WHEREAS, Proficiency in more than one language enhances 11

12 communication and strengthens positive interactions among people

13 in the United States and around the world; and

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1 WHEREAS, The study of languages improves the academic 2 and literacy skills of pupils, leading to increased levels of 3 achievement on verbal and quantitative examinations; and

- 4 WHEREAS, The study of languages and cultures provides 5 insight into the history, heritage, and perspectives of all California 6 residents and of residents of other communities around the world; 7 and
- 8 WHEREAS, The conditions of the current international economy 9 require that Californians be able to interact effectively with persons
- 10 from different cultural backgrounds; and
- WHEREAS, Linguistic and cultural competence is critical tothe security needs of the United States; and
- WHEREAS, The study of languages and cultures increasesunderstanding of, and encourages respect for, people of different
- 15 backgrounds; and
- WHEREAS, During the month of May 2009 the California Language Teachers' Association, the California Foreign Language Project, the University of California Consortium for Language Learning and Teaching, and other educational organizations throughout California will sponsor special activities to promote awareness of the importance of California residents being able to interact successfully in multilingual and multicultural contexts in
- 23 the United States and around the world; now, therefore, be it
- 24 Resolved by the Assembly of the State of California, the Senate 25 thereof concurring, That the Legislature hereby proclaims the 26 month of May 2009 as World Languages and Cultures Month, during which time the Legislature encourages all educational 27 communities in California to celebrate languages and cultures with 28 29 appropriate pupil activities and programs that promote an 30 understanding of the diversity of languages and cultures in 31 California and the benefit that they represent to our nation, and 32 urges all residents to become interested in and give full support to 33 quality language and cultural programs for all pupils in California
