Assembly Concurrent Resolution No. 148—Relative to the Armenian Martyrs Memorial.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

ACR 148, as amended, Charles Calderon. Armenian *Genocide* Martyrs Memorial.

This measure would request *that* the Department of Transportation ~~to~~ erect informational signs on State Highway Route 60 in the County of Los Angeles directing motorists to the Armenian *Genocide* Martyrs Monument, consistent with the signing requirements for the state highway system and upon receiving donations from nonstate sources sufficient to cover the cost to erect those signs.

Fiscal committee: yes.

- 1 WHEREAS, The Armenian *Genocide* Martyrs Monument was
- 2 erected in 1965 in Bicknell Park in the City of Montebello; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The Armenian *Genocide* Martyrs Monument is
- 4 the site of religious and cultural commemorations by the Armenian
- 5 community in southern California; and

1 WHEREAS, The Armenian *Genocide* Martyrs Monument serves  
2 as a beacon of awareness ~~for cultural tolerance~~ *of all crimes against*  
3 *humanity*; now, therefore, be it

4 *Resolved by the Assembly of the State of California, the Senate*  
5 *thereof concurring*, That the Legislature recognizes the importance  
6 of the Armenian *Genocide* Martyrs Monument to the people of  
7 California and requests *that* the Department of Transportation ~~to~~  
8 erect informational signs on the westbound portion of State  
9 Highway Route 60 leading to the Garfield Avenue exit and the  
10 eastbound portion of State Highway Route 60 leading to the  
11 Garfield Avenue exit, in the County of Los Angeles, directing  
12 motorists to the Armenian *Genocide* Martyrs Monument, consistent  
13 with the signing requirements for the state highway system and  
14 upon receiving donations from nonstate sources sufficient to cover  
15 the cost to erect those signs; and be it further

16 *Resolved*, That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly transmit copies  
17 of this resolution to the Department of Transportation and to the  
18 author for appropriate distribution.
