An act to amend Section 4581 of the Public Resources Code, relating to forest practices.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1056, as introduced, Tom Berryhill. Forest practices: timber harvesting plans.

The Z'berg-Nejedly Forest Practice Act of 1973 prohibits a person from conducting timber operations, as defined, unless a timber harvesting plan prepared by a registered professional forester has been submitted to the Department of Forestry and Fire Protection, and approved.

This bill would make technical, nonsubstantive changes to those provisions.

*The people of the State of California do enact as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 4581 of the Public Resources Code is  
2 amended to read:  
3 4581. ~~No~~A person shall *not* conduct timber operations unless  
4 a timber harvesting plan prepared by a registered professional  
5 forester has been submitted for ~~such~~ *those* operations to the  
6 department pursuant to this article. ~~Such~~*The timber harvesting*

1 plan shall be required in addition to the license required in Section  
2 4571.
