An act to amend Sections 382 and 430 of the Streets and Highways Code, relating to highways.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1670, as amended, Beall. State Highway Routes 82 and 130: relinquishment.

Existing law gives the Department of Transportation full possession and control of all state highways. Existing law describes the authorized routes in the state highway system and establishes a process for adoption of a highway on an authorized route by the California Transportation Commission. Existing law also authorizes the commission to relinquish certain state highway segments to local agencies.

This bill would authorize the commission to relinquish to the City of San Jose specified portions of State Highway Routes 82 and 130, under certain conditions.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: yes.
State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 382 of the Streets and Highways Code
- 2 is amended to read:

1 382. (a) Route 82 is from Route 101 near Blossom Hill Road
2 in San Jose to Route 280 in San Francisco.

3 (b) Upon a determination by the commission that it is in the
4 best interests of the state to do so, the commission, may, upon
5 terms and conditions approved by it, relinquish to the City of San
6 Jose the portion of Route 82 from Route 101 to Route 880 in that
7 city if ~~the city agrees to accept it~~ *department and the city enter*
8 *into an agreement providing for that relinquishment*. The following
9 conditions shall apply upon relinquishment:

10 (1) The relinquishment shall become effective on the date
11 following the county recorder's recordation of the relinquishment
12 resolution containing the commission's approval of the terms and
13 conditions of the relinquishment.

14 (2) On and after the effective date of the relinquishment, the
15 relinquished portion of Route 82 shall cease to be a state highway.

16 (3) The portion of Route 82 relinquished under this subdivision
17 shall be ineligible for future adoption under Section 81.

18 (4) For the portion of Route 82 that is relinquished under this
19 subdivision, the City of San Jose shall install and maintain within
20 the jurisdiction of the city signs directing motorists to the
21 continuation of Route 82 to the extent deemed necessary by the
22 department.

23 SEC. 2. Section 430 of the Streets and Highways Code is
24 amended to read:

25 430. (a) Route 130 is from Route 101 in San Jose to Route 33
26 near Patterson via the vicinity of Mount Hamilton.

27 (b) Upon a determination by the commission that it is in the
28 best interests of the state to do so, the commission, may, upon
29 terms and conditions approved by it, relinquish to the City of San
30 Jose the portion of Route 130 within the city limits of the City of
31 San Jose if ~~the city agrees to accept it~~ *department and the city enter*
32 *into an agreement providing for that relinquishment*. The following
33 conditions shall apply upon relinquishment:

34 (1) The relinquishment shall become effective on the date
35 following the county recorder's recordation of the relinquishment
36 resolution containing the commission's approval of the terms and
37 conditions of the relinquishment.

38 (2) On and after the effective date of the relinquishment, the
39 relinquished portion of Route 130 shall cease to be a state highway.

- 1 (3) The portion of Route 130 relinquished under this subdivision
2 shall be ineligible for future adoption under Section 81.
3 (4) For the portion of Route 130 that is relinquished under this
4 subdivision, the City of San Jose shall install and maintain within
5 the jurisdiction of the city signs directing motorists to the
6 continuation of Route 130.

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
