An act to amend Section 12301.5 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, relating to public social services.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1875, as introduced, Fong. In-home supportive services.

Existing law provides for the In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS) program, under which, either through employment by the recipient, or by or through a contract by the county, a nonprofit consortium, or a public authority, qualified aged, blind, and disabled persons receive services enabling them to remain in their homes.

This bill would make technical, nonsubstantive changes to an In-Home Supportive Services program provision.
