## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

An act to add Section 19604.7 to, and to repeal Article 9.1 (commencing with Section 19604.5) of Chapter 4 of Division 8 of, the Business and Professions Code, relating to horse racing.

## LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2414, John A. Pérez. Horse racing: exchange wagering.

SB 1072 of the 2009–10 Regular Session would enact provisions relating to exchange wagering, as defined.

This bill would make those provisions inoperative on May 1, 2016, and would repeal them on January 1, 2017.

This bill would become operative only if SB 1072 of the 2009–10 Regular Session is enacted and this bill is enacted last.

*The people of the State of California do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 19604.7 is added to the Business and Professions Code, to read:

19604.7. This article shall become inoperative on May 1, 2016, and, as of January 1, 2017, is repealed, unless a later enacted statute, that becomes operative on or before January 1, 2017, deletes or extends the dates on which it becomes inoperative and is repealed.

SEC. 2. Section 1 of this act shall become operative only if SB 1072 of the 2009–10 Regular Session is enacted, that bill adds Article 9.1 (commencing with Section 19604.5) to Chapter 4 of Division 8 of the Business and Professions Code, and this bill is enacted last.
