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**Introduced by Assembly Member Hagman**

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An act to amend Section 2070 of the Insurance Code, relating to insurance.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2606, as introduced, Hagman. Insurance: fire: standard form policy.

Existing law requires that all fire insurance policies on subject matter in this state be on the adopted standard form, except as provided.

This bill would make technical, nonsubstantive changes to that provision.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

*The people of the State of California do enact as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 2070 of the Insurance Code is amended  
2 to read:  
3 2070. All fire policies on subject matter in California shall be  
4 on the standard form, and, except as provided by this article shall  
5 not contain additions ~~thereto~~ *to the form*. No part of the standard  
6 form shall be omitted ~~therefrom~~ except that any policy providing  
7 coverage against the peril of fire only, or in combination with  
8 coverage against other perils, need not comply with the provisions  
9 of the standard form of fire insurance policy or Section 2080;  
10 provided, that coverage with respect to the peril of fire, when

- 1 viewed in its entirety, is substantially equivalent to or more
- 2 favorable to the insured than that contained in ~~such~~ *the* standard
- 3 form fire insurance policy.
