Senate Resolution No. 52—Relative to salary disclosure.

1 WHEREAS, Recent revelations regarding excessive
2 compensation in some local jurisdictions indicate the need for full
3 public access to governmental decision-making processes, and to
4 the consequences of such decisions; and

5 WHEREAS, The Senate has long complied fully with the
6 provisions of the Legislative Open Records Act, providing
7 information when requested in a timely manner and in a format
8 required by current law; and

9 WHEREAS, In recent years, new formats for information
10 disclosure have been developed that provide the public with more
11 immediate, convenient, and user-friendly displays of information
12 through the media and the Internet; now, therefore, be it

13 *Resolved by the Senate of the State of California,* That the
14 Secretary of the Senate is directed to make available to the public,
15 on the Senate’s Internet Web site, full information regarding the
16 salaries of Members, officers, and employees of the Senate.
