An act to amend Section 51221.5 of the Education Code, relating to curriculum.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 236, as introduced, Huff. Curriculum.

Existing law requires that the adopted course of study for grades 7 to 12, inclusive, offer courses in career technical education. These provisions define "vocational-technical education" and "career technical education" as education designed and conducted for the purpose of preparing youth for gainful employment in the occupations and in the numbers that are appropriate to the personnel needs of the state and the community served and relevant to the career desires and needs of the pupils.

This bill would make a technical, nonsubstantive change to those provisions.
