LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 526, as amended, Ashburn. Intercity rail: study. San Joaquin Corridor: Altamont Pass extension.

Existing law provides for the Department of Transportation to contract with Amtrak for intercity rail services and connecting feeder buses.

This bill would state the intent of the Legislature to enact legislation to require the Department of Transportation to study the potential for increasing ridership by routing certain Amtrak intercity rail services over the Altamont Pass alignment between the Central Valley and the Bay Area enter into negotiations with the relevant operating freight and passenger commuter railroads for the purpose of developing a service plan and an operating agreement for the extension of at least one San Joaquin Corridor intercity passenger train using the Altamont Corridor to and from San Francisco. The bill would require the department to report to the Legislature by March 31, 2010, on the status of the negotiations.
