

**Introduced by Senator Aanestad**

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An act to amend Section 1000 of the Business and Professions Code, relating to chiropractors.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 761, as introduced, Aanestad. Chiropractors.

Existing law provides for the licensure and regulation of chiropractors by the State Board of Chiropractic Examiners.

This bill would make nonsubstantive and technical changes to those provisions.

*The people of the State of California do enact as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 1000 of the Business and Professions
- 2 Code is amended to read:
- 3 1000. The law governing practitioners of chiropractic is found
- 4 in an initiative act entitled "An act prescribing the terms upon
- 5 which licenses may be issued to practitioners of chiropractic,
- 6 creating the State Board of Chiropractic Examiners and declaring
- 7 its powers and duties, prescribing penalties for violation hereof,
- 8 and repealing all acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith,"
- 9 *which was* adopted by the electors November 7, 1922.

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
