An act to amend Section 65100 of the Government Code, relating to land use.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 1333, as introduced, Yee. Land use: local entities.

Existing law establishes the Planning and Zoning Law. Existing law provides within each city and county a planning agency with the powers necessary to carry out the purposes of the Planning and Zoning Law, as specified.

This bill would make a technical, nonsubstantive change to that provision.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 65100 of the Government Code is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 65100. There is in each city and county a planning agency with
- 4 the powers *that are* necessary to carry out the purposes of this title.
- 5 The legislative body of each city and county shall by ordinance
- 6 assign the functions of the planning agency to a planning
- 7 department, one or more planning commissions, administrative
- 8 bodies or hearing officers, the legislative body itself, or any
- 9 combination thereof, as it deems appropriate and necessary. In the

- 1 absence of an assignment, the legislative body shall carry out all
- 2 the functions of the planning agency.
