

ASSEMBLY BILL

Introduced by Assembly Member Davis

January 31, 2011

An act to amend Section 22457 of the Business and Professions Code, relating to business.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 214, as introduced, Davis. Professional photocopiers.

Existing law provides for regulation of professional photocopiers, including a requirement for issuance of an identification card by the county clerk.

This bill would require the identification card for an employee of a professional photocopier or a partnership or corporation to contain a photograph of the employee. By imposing additional duties on county clerks, the bill would impose a state-mandated local program.

The California Constitution requires the state to reimburse local agencies and school districts for certain costs mandated by the state. Statutory provisions establish procedures for making that reimbursement.

This bill would provide that, if the Commission on State Mandates determines that the bill contains costs mandated by the state, reimbursement for those costs shall be made pursuant to these statutory provisions.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: yes.

State-mandated local program: yes.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 22457 of the Business and Professions
2 Code is amended to read:

3 22457. (a) The county clerk shall maintain a register of
4 professional photocopiers, assign a number to each professional
5 photocopier, and issue an identification card to each one.
6 Additional cards for employees of professional photocopiers shall
7 be issued upon the payment of ten dollars (\$10) for each card.
8 Upon renewal of registration, the same number shall be assigned,
9 provided there is no lapse in the period of registration.

10 (b) The identification card shall be a card not less than 3¼
11 inches by 2 inches, and shall contain at the top the title,
12 “Professional Photocopier” followed by the registrant’s name,
13 address, registration number, date of expiration, and county of
14 registration. It shall also contain a photograph of the registrant in
15 the lower left corner. The identification card for a partnership or
16 corporation registration shall be issued in the name of the
17 partnership or corporation, and shall not contain a photograph. *The*
18 *identification card for an employee of a professional photocopier*
19 *or a partnership or corporation shall contain a photograph of the*
20 *employee in the lower left corner.*

21 (c) The identification card for an employee of a *professional*
22 *photocopier or a partnership or corporation* shall be issued in the
23 name of the employee and include “Employee of: [insert name of
24 the *professional photocopier or the partnership or corporation*].”

25 SEC. 2. If the Commission on State Mandates determines that
26 this act contains costs mandated by the state, reimbursement to
27 local agencies and school districts for those costs shall be made
28 pursuant to Part 7 (commencing with Section 17500) of Division
29 4 of Title 2 of the Government Code.
