An act to amend Section 72 of the Labor Code, relating to employment.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 872, as introduced, Jones. Employment: compensation.

Existing law provides for members of the Industrial Welfare Commission to receive specified compensation for their official activities.

This bill would make a nonsubstantive change to this provision.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no.
State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 72 of the Labor Code is amended to read:
2 72. The members of the commission shall receive one hundred
3 dollars (\$100) for each ~~day's~~ *day of* actual attendance at meetings
4 and other official business of the commission and shall receive
5 their actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance
6 of their duties.
