An act to amend Section 6731.1 of the Business and Professions Code, relating to engineers.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1210, as introduced, Garrick. Civil engineering.

Existing law establishes the Board for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors in the Department of Consumer Affairs. Existing law recognizes various engineering disciplines. Existing law provides that civil engineering embraces certain studies or activities in connection with specified fixed works and also includes specified practices.

This bill would make nonsubstantive changes to these provisions.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 4 to practice, either in a public or private capacity, all of the
- 5 following:
- 6 (a) ~~Locates, relocates, establishes, reestablishes, or retraces~~
- 7 *Locating, relocating, establishing, reestablishing, or retracing* the
- 8 alignment or elevation for any of the fixed works embraced within
- 9 the practice of civil engineering, as described in Section 6731.

- 1 (b) ~~Determines~~ *Determining* the configuration or contour of the
- 2 earth's surface or the position of fixed objects above, on, or below
- 3 the surface of *the* earth by applying the principles of trigonometry
- 4 or photogrammetry.
- 5 (c) ~~Creates, prepares, or modifies~~ *Creating, preparing, or*
- 6 *modifying* electronic or computerized data in the performance of
- 7 the activities described in subdivisions (a) and (b).
- 8 (d) ~~Renders~~ *Rendering* a statement regarding the accuracy of
- 9 maps or measured survey data pursuant to subdivisions (a), (b),
- 10 and (c).
