An act relating to peace officers.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1270, as introduced, Ammiano. Peace officers: citizen review commissions.

Existing law requires each agency that employs peace officers to establish a procedure to investigate complaints by members of the public against the personnel of these agencies and to make a written description of the procedure available to the public.

This bill would declare the intent of the Legislature to enact legislation to establish guiding principles for the development and operation of citizen peace officer review commissions.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no.

- 2 legislation to establish guiding principles for the development and
- 3 operation of citizen peace officer review commissions.
