LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1302, as introduced, Williams. Energy: renewable energy technologies.

Existing law establishes various programs to encourage the development of renewable energy technologies.

This bill would state the intent of the Legislature to enact legislation to establish a program to support emerging renewable technologies in distributed generation, with specified objectives.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

*The people of the State of California do enact as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. It is the intent of the Legislature to enact  
2 legislation to establish a new program to support emerging  
3 renewable technologies in distributed generation, with the  
4 objectives of reducing peak demand, reducing greenhouse gas  
5 emissions, enhancing grid reliability, and encouraging fuel  
6 diversity.
