Introduced by Assembly Member Fletcher

An act to amend Section 30500 of the Public Resources Code, relating to coastal resources.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1336, as introduced, Fletcher. Coastal resources: local coastal programs.

Existing law requires each local government lying, in whole or in part, within the coastal zone to prepare a local coastal program for that portion of the coastal zone within its jurisdiction. Existing law requires that the local coastal program prepared pursuant to these provisions also contain a specific public access component to assure that maximum public access to the coast and public recreation areas is provided.

This bill would make a technical, nonsubstantive change to these provisions.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no.
State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 30500 of the Public Resources Code is
2 amended to read:
3 30500. (a) Each local government lying, in whole or in part,
4 within the coastal zone shall prepare a local coastal program for
5 that portion of the coastal zone within its jurisdiction. However,
6 any local government may request, in writing, the commission to

1 prepare a local coastal program, or a portion thereof, for the local
2 government. Each local coastal program prepared pursuant to this
3 chapter shall contain a specific public access component to ~~assure~~
4 *ensure* that maximum public access to the coast and public
5 recreation areas is provided.

6 (b) Amendments to a local general plan for the purpose of
7 developing a certified local coastal program shall not constitute
8 an amendment of a general plan for purposes of Section 65358 of
9 the Government Code.

10 (c) The precise content of each local coastal program shall be
11 determined by the local government, consistent with Section 30501,
12 in full consultation with the commission and with full public
13 participation.
