An act to add Article 5.5 (commencing with Section 12245) to Chapter 3 of Part 2 of Division 3 of Title 2 of the Government Code, relating to city officials.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1355, as amended, Lara. City officials: standards.

Existing law requires the Secretary of State to, among other things, upon appropriation by the Legislature, publish and distribute a roster of the state and local public officials in California.

This bill would require the Secretary of State to, in consultation with the Controller, *the Treasurer*, and the League of California Cities, develop and set forth recommendations for minimal educational and certification standards for city clerks, city managers, and city treasurers, whether elected or appointed, and to post those standards on the Secretary of State's Internet Web site.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: yes.
State-mandated local program: no.
