Introduced by Assembly Member Solorio

An act to amend Section 271 of the Penal Code, relating to crimes.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1387, as introduced, Solorio. Crimes: child abandonment.

Existing law provides that every parent of any child under the age of 14 years, and every person to whom that child has been confided for nurture, or education, who deserts that child in any place whatever with intent to abandon that child, is punishable by imprisonment in the state prison or in the county jail not exceeding one year or by fine not exceeding \$1,000 or by both that fine and imprisonment.

This bill would increase the fine specified above to a fine not exceeding \$1,500.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:
