An act to amend Section 3001 of the Elections Code, relating to elections.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1724, as introduced, Fong. Elections: vote by mail voting.

Under existing law, an application for a vote by mail ballot shall be made by a voter to an elections official having jurisdiction over the election between the 29th and 7th days prior to the election.

This bill would make nonsubstantive changes to the above-described provisions.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no.
State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 3001 of the Elections Code is amended
- 2 to read:
- 3 3001. Except as provided in Chapter 3 (commencing with
- 4 Section 3200) and Sections 3007.5 and 3007.7, application for a
- 5 vote by mail voter's ballot shall be made in writing to the elections
- 6 official having jurisdiction over the election between the 29th and
- 7 the 7th day prior to the election. The application shall be signed
- 8 by the applicant and shall show his or her place of residence. Any
- 9 applications received by the elections official prior to the 29th day

1 *prior to the election* shall be kept and processed during the
2 application period.
