An act to amend Section 66201 of the Education Code, relating to public postsecondary education.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2316, as introduced, Hueso. Public postsecondary education: admissions.

Existing law states the intent of the Legislature that each resident of California who has the capacity and motivation to benefit from higher education should have the opportunity to enroll in an institution of higher education.

This bill would make nonsubstantive changes to that statement.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 66201 of the Education Code is amended
2 to read:
3 66201. (a) It is the intent of the Legislature that ~~each~~ every
4 resident of California who has the capacity and motivation to
5 benefit from higher education should have the opportunity to enroll
6 in an institution of higher education. Once enrolled, ~~each~~ an
7 individual should have the opportunity to continue as long and as
8 far as his or her capacity and motivation, as indicated by academic
9 performance and commitment to educational advancement, will

1 lead him or her to meet academic standards and institutional
2 requirements.

4 (b) *The* Legislature hereby reaffirms the commitment of the
5 State of California to provide an appropriate place in California
6 public higher education for every student who is willing and able
7 to benefit from attendance.
