LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 2372, as introduced, Hill. Service of process: attorneys.

Existing law provides for service of process and other notices by various means, including by mail or in person, and specifies the conditions for those various means of service of process.

This bill would provide that, notwithstanding any other law, service of process by a client, former client, or officer of the court is effective upon an attorney if mailed to the address for the attorney appearing on the attorney's profile on the Internet Web site of the State Bar.
