Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 68—Relative to the Joint Committee for the Protection of Lake Tahoe.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SCR 68, as introduced, Gaines. Joint Committee for the Protection of Lake Tahoe.

This measure would establish the Joint Committee for the Protection of Lake Tahoe. The joint committee would be composed of 3 Members from each house of the Legislature, appointed as specified. The joint committee would be authorized to act until January 1, 2015, at which time its existence would be terminated.

Fiscal committee: no.

2 *thereof concurring,* That the Joint Committee for the Protection
3 of Lake Tahoe is hereby established; and be it further
4 *Resolved,* That the Joint Committee for the Protection of Lake
5 Tahoe shall consist of six members, appointed as follows:
6 (a) Three Members of the Assembly appointed by the Speaker
7 of the Assembly, with two Members from the majority party and
8 one Member from the minority party.
9 (b) Three Members of the Senate appointed by the Senate
10 Committee on Rules, with two Members from the majority party
11 and one Member from the minority party; and be it further
12 *Resolved,* That the chairperson and vice chairperson of the Joint
13 Committee for the Protection of Lake Tahoe shall be Members of

- 1 different parties, with the party of the Member in each position
- 2 rotating annually; and be it further
- 3 *Resolved*, That the Joint Committee for the Protection of Lake
- 4 Tahoe is authorized to act until January 1, 2015, at which time the
- 5 committee's existence shall terminate.

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
