LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SCR 93, as amended, Vargas. Randy Sanchez Memorial Bridge.

This measure would designate a specified bridge over-State Highway Route Interstate 905 as the Randy Sanchez Memorial Bridge. The measure would also request the Department of Transportation to determine the cost of appropriate signs showing this special designation and, upon receiving donations from nonstate sources covering those costs, to erect those signs.

- 6 manager for the preliminary stages of the entire State Highway
- 7 Route Interstate 905 project from State Highway Route 805 to the
- 8 Otay Mesa Port of Entry; and
- 9 WHEREAS, On September 21, 2004, Randy was tragically
- 10 killed at the age of 37. While riding to work on his motorcycle, he
- 11 was struck by a motorist who ran a red light, killing him instantly;
