LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 782, as introduced, Dutton. Presidential primary elections.

Existing law specifies the date for a presidential primary.

This bill would make a nonsubstantive change to that provision of existing law.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no.  
State-mandated local program: no.

*The people of the State of California do enact as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 1202 of the Elections Code is amended
- 2 to read:
- 3 1202. The presidential primary shall be held on the first
- 4 Tuesday in February in any year evenly divisible by the number
- 5 four; and shall not be consolidated with the statewide direct primary
- 6 held in that year.
