SENATE BILL

No. 1103

Introduced by Senator Wright

February 16, 2012

An act to amend Section 69433.2 of the Education Code, relating to student financial aid.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 1103, as amended, Wright. Cal Grant Program: annual report.

Existing law establishes the Cal Grant Program under the administration of the Student Aid Commission, and establishes eligibility requirements for awards under the program for participating students attending qualifying institutions. Existing law requires each Cal Grant participating institution, as a condition for its voluntary participation in the Cal Grant Program, to annually report to the commission specified information for its undergraduate programs.

This bill would require the commission, *commencing on a specified date*, to provide on its Internet Web site the information submitted by a Cal Grant participating institution pursuant to the reporting requirement described above, *which would be required to be made available in a searchable database*, and other specified information and links that are useful to students and parents who are in the process of selecting a college or university.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 69433.2 of the Education Code is

3 69433.2. (a) As a condition for its voluntary participation in
4 the Cal Grant Program, each Cal Grant participating institution
5 shall, beginning in 2012, annually report to the commission, and
6 as further specified in the institutional participation agreement,
7 both of the following for its undergraduate programs:

8 (1) Enrollment, persistence, and graduation data for all students,
9 including aggregate information on Cal Grant recipients.

10 (2) The job placement rate and salary and wage information for
11 each program that is either designed or advertised to lead to a
12 particular type of job or advertised or promoted with a claim
13 regarding job placement.

14 (b) ~~The~~ *Commencing the year after the commission begins to*
15 *receive reports pursuant to subdivision (a), the commission shall*
16 *provide both of the following on its Internet Web site:*

17 (1) The information submitted by a Cal Grant participating
18 institution pursuant to subdivision (a), *which shall be made*
19 *available in a searchable database.*

20 (2) Other information and links that are useful to students and
21 parents who are in the process of selecting a college or university.
22 This information may include, but not be limited to, local
23 occupational profiles available through the Employment
24 Development Department’s Labor Market Information Data
25 Library.

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
