An act to amend Section 20370 of the Government Code, relating to public employees' retirement.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 1132, as introduced, Walters. Public Employees' Retirement System.

The Public Employees' Retirement Law (PERL) creates the Public Employees' Retirement System, which provides a defined benefit to its members based on age at retirement, service credit, and final compensation. Existing law defines "member" for purposes of PERL.

This bill would make a technical, nonsubstantive change to that provision.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 20370 of the Government Code is

- 3 20370. (a) "Member" means an employee who has qualified
- 4 for membership in this system and on whose behalf an employer
- 5 has become obligated to pay contributions.
- 6 (b) "State member" includes:
- 7 (1) State miscellaneous members.
- 8 (2) University members.
- 9 (3) Patrol members.
- 10 (4) State safety members.

- 1 (5) State industrial members.
- 2 (6) State peace officer/firefighter members.
- 3 (7) National Guard members as defined in Section 20380.5.
- 4 (c) “Local member” includes:
- 5 (1) Local miscellaneous members.
- 6 (2) Local safety members.
- 7 (d) “School member” includes all employees within the
- 8 jurisdiction of a school employer, other than local police officers,
- 9 school safety members, and members included in a risk pool.
