An act to amend Sections 11553 and 11553.5 of the Government Code, relating to the Unemployment Insurance Appeals Board.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 1263, as introduced, Vargas. Unemployment Insurance Appeals Board: annual salary.

Existing law requires that an annual salary of \$81,635, to be increased as specified, be paid to the Chairperson of the Unemployment Insurance Appeals Board. Existing law establishes the annual salary for each member of the board at \$79,122, to be increased, as specified.

This bill would delete the salary provisions for the chairperson and members of the Unemployment Insurance Appeals Board.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: yes. State-mandated local program: no.
