Assembly Concurrent Resolution No. 28—Relative to the Armed Forces.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

ACR 28, as introduced, Nazarian. Armed Forces Day.

This measure would honor and recognize the service and sacrifice made by members of the Armed Forces and their families on the occasion of Armed Forces Day on May 18, 2013.

- 1 WHEREAS, Armed Forces Day was created in 1949 in
2 connection with the consolidation of the military services in the
3 United States Department of Defense; and
4 WHEREAS, The purpose of Armed Forces Day is to honor the
5 men and women who are serving in the Army, Navy, Marine Corps,
6 Air Force, and Coast Guard, including the National Guard and
7 Reserve components; and
8 WHEREAS, Armed Forces Day is celebrated on the third
9 Saturday in May, which this year is May 18, 2013; and
10 WHEREAS, Members of the Armed Forces have performed
11 tremendous service on behalf of the United States; and
12 WHEREAS, Members of the Armed Forces have been killed
13 and injured in operations to bring peace and stability in the name
14 of democracy; and

1 WHEREAS, All Americans express their recognition and
2 gratitude for members of the Armed Forces at home and abroad;
3 now, therefore, be it

4 *Resolved by the Assembly of the State of California, the Senate*
5 *thereof concurring*, That the Legislature, on the occasion of Armed
6 Forces Day 2013;

7 (1) Honors and recognizes the service and sacrifice that members
8 of the Armed Forces and their families gave, and continue to give,
9 to the United States;

10 (2) Remains committed to supporting the members of the Armed
11 Forces and their families;

12 (3) Encourages Americans to show their support and
13 appreciation for members of the Armed Forces on Armed Forces
14 Day;

15 (4) Commends the actions of private citizens and organizations
16 who volunteer to support America's wounded warriors; and

17 (5) Expresses the gratitude of the American people to the
18 members of the Armed Forces for their service on behalf of the
19 United States; and be it further

20 *Resolved*, That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly transmit copies
