~~An act relating to the Budget Act of 2013.~~ *An act to amend the Budget Act of 2012 (Chapters 21 and 29 of the Statutes of 2012) by augmenting Item 9840-001-0001 of Section 2.00 of that act, relating to the state budget, and making an appropriation therefor, to take effect immediately, budget bill.*

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 95, as amended, Committee on Budget. ~~Budget Act of 2013.~~ *Budget Act of 2012: augmentation.*

The Budget Act of 2012 appropriated specified amounts from the General Fund for the support of state government.

This bill would appropriate \$497,299,976 from the General Fund in augmentation of a specified appropriation in the Budget Act of 2012, regarding augmentations for contingencies and emergencies, and would require the Controller to allocate this additional amount according to a specified schedule.

This bill would declare that it is to take effect immediately as a Budget Bill.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sum of four hundred ninety-seven million two
2 hundred ninety-nine thousand nine hundred seventy-six dollars
3 (\$497,299,976) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for
4 expenditure for the 2012–13 fiscal year in augmentation of Item
5 9840-001-0001 of Section 2.00 of the Budget Act of 2012 (Chapters
6 21 and 29 of the Statutes of 2012). Notwithstanding Provision 7
7 of Item 9840-001-0001, these funds shall be allocated by the
8 Controller in accordance with the following schedule:

9 (a) Four hundred eighty-two million eight hundred seventy
10 thousand dollars (\$482,870,000) to Schedule (3) 20.10.030-Benefits
11 (Medical Care and Services), of Item 4260-101-0001.

12 (b) Two million six hundred thirty-three thousand dollars
13 (\$2,633,000) to Schedule (1) 20-Developmental Centers Program,
14 of Item 4300-003-0001.

15 (c) Five million six hundred fifty-seven thousand dollars
16 (\$5,657,000) to Schedule (2) 10.10.020-Purchase of Services, of
17 Item 4300-101-0001.

18 (d) Two hundred twenty-four thousand nine hundred seventy-six
19 dollars (\$224,976) to Item 9300-101-0001.

20 (e) Five million nine hundred fifteen thousand dollars
21 (\$5,915,000) to Schedule (1) Health benefit premiums, of Item
22 9650-001-0001.

23 SEC. 2. Any unencumbered balances, as of June 30, 2013, of
24 the funds appropriated within any of the items identified in Section
25 1 shall revert to the General Fund.

26 SEC. 3. This act is a Budget Bill within the meaning of
27 subdivision (e) of Section 12 of Article IV of the California
28 Constitution and shall take effect immediately.
