Assembly Concurrent Resolution No. 58—Relative to women in business.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

ACR 58, as amended, Beth Gaines. California Business Women's Day.

This measure would designate September 22, 2013, and September 22, 2014, as "California Business Women's Day" and would encourage all Californians to celebrate the occasion with appropriate activities.

1 WHEREAS, There are approximately 1 million women-owned
2 businesses in California and women-owned businesses constitute
3 48.6 percent of all privately held businesses in California; and

4 WHEREAS, Women-owned businesses in California employ
5 approximately 2.9 million people and generate approximately \$406
6 billion in revenue; and

7 WHEREAS, In 2012, among the 50 states and Washington,
8 D.C., California ranked first in the number of privately held,
9 women-owned businesses. Women-owned businesses have grown
10 by 51 percent in California with a 56-percent increase in revenue
11 for women-owned businesses and a 4-percent increase in
12 employment; and

13 WHEREAS, California has 12 Fortune 100 companies, all of
14 which have at least one woman director, and 75 percent of which
15 have two or more women directors; and

16 WHEREAS, California ranks first in the nation with the greatest
17 number of Hispanic, Asian, and Pacific Islander women-owned
18 businesses and fourth for the greatest number of African American
19 women-owned businesses; and

20 WHEREAS, Minority women-owned businesses comprise 35
21 percent of all women-owned businesses in California, making
22 California the third leading state where minority women-owned
23 businesses comprise the greatest share of all women-owned
24 businesses; and

25 WHEREAS, September 22 marks the founding date in 1949 of
26 the American Business Women's Association, the mission of which
27 is "to bring together businesswomen of diverse occupations and
28 to provide opportunities for them to help themselves and others
29 grow personally and professionally through leadership, education,
30 networking support and national recognition"; now, therefore, be
31 it

32 *Resolved by the Assembly of the State of California, the Senate*
33 *thereof concurring*, That September 22, 2013, and September 22,
34 2014, shall be designated as "California Business Women's Day"
35 and all Californians are encouraged to celebrate the occasion with
36 appropriate activities; and be it further

37 *Resolved*, That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly provide copies
38 of this resolution to the author for appropriate distribution.
