An act relating to the Budget Act of 2013. An act to amend the Budget Act of 2012 by amending Items 0890-001-0001 and 0890-001-0228 of Section 2.00 of that act, relating to the state budget, and making an appropriation therefor, to take effect immediately, budget bill.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 113, as amended, Committee on Budget. Budget Act of ~~2013~~ 2012.

The Budget Act of 2012 appropriated \$53,526,000 to the Secretary of State for purposes of filings and registrations during the 2012–13 fiscal year.

This bill would increase this appropriation by \$2,000,000 to \$55,526,000. The bill would require that this increase be used for costs associated with reducing the processing time for business filings and require the Secretary of State to report on the 30th day of each month to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee on the Secretary of State's progress in achieving those reductions.

This bill would declare that it is to take effect immediately as a Budget Bill.

This bill would express the intent of the Legislature to enact statutory changes relating to the Budget Act of 2013.
