LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 220, as introduced, Ting. Vehicles: low emissions: financial incentives.

Existing law requires the Department of Motor Vehicles to make available for issuance, for a specified fee, distinctive decals, labels, and other identifiers that clearly distinguish specified vehicles from other vehicles, including, but not limited to, a vehicle that meets California's super ultra-low emission vehicle (SULEV) standard for exhaust emissions and the federal inherently low-emission vehicle (ILEV) evaporative emission standard, as defined.

This bill would state the intent of the Legislature to enact legislation to develop and implement a policy consisting of financial incentives to promote the purchase of certain low-emission vehicles.

- 1 SECTION 1. It is the intent of the Legislature to enact
- 2 legislation to develop and implement a policy consisting of

- 1 financial incentives to promote the purchase of low-emission
- 2 vehicles described in Section 5205.5 of the Vehicle Code.
