An act to amend Section 99214 of the Public Utilities Code, relating to public transit.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 466, as introduced, Quirk-Silva. Public transportation: local transportation fund.

Existing law provides for the allocation by the designated transportation planning agency of funds in a county's local transportation fund derived from $\frac{1}{4}\%$ of the sales tax to transit operators for public transportation purposes and, in certain cases, to cities and counties for street and road purposes. Existing law defines "transportation planning agency" for these purposes.

This bill would make a nonsubstantive change to this definitional provision.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 4 designated in Section 29532 or 29532.1 of the Government Code.
- 5 (b) "Transportation planning agency" also includes, for purposes
- 6 of this chapter, the county transportation commissions created in

1 the Counties of Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino,
2 and Ventura pursuant to Division 12 (commencing with Section
3 130000).

4 (c) “Transportation planning agency” also includes, for purposes
5 of this chapter, the Imperial County Transportation Commission
6 in Imperial County.
