An act to amend Section 27421 of the Government Code, relating to county assessors.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 846, as introduced, Achadjian. County assessors: duties.

Existing law requires the county assessor in each county who is designated to perform the duty of assessing property for a local taxing jurisdiction to provide an estimate of the assessed valuation of property within the jurisdiction, as specified.

This bill would make technical, nonsubstantive changes to those provisions.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 27421 of the Government Code is
2 amended to read:
3 27421. The county assessor in each county who is designated
4 to perform the duty of assessing property for a local taxing
5 jurisdiction shall, upon request of the governing body of ~~such that~~
6 jurisdiction, excluding a school district, ~~furnish~~ *provide* not later
7 than May 15th of each year an estimate of the assessed valuation
8 of property within ~~such that~~ jurisdiction for the ~~succeeding next~~
9 fiscal year. Such request shall be made on or before February 20th

- 1 of each year. The estimate ~~required herein~~ shall contain estimates
- 2 of the total of each of the items contained on the assessment roll
- 3 as well as the estimated total valuation.
