An act to amend Section 1020 of the Streets and Highways Code, relating to county highways.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 847, as introduced, Hueso. Road districts: boundaries.

Existing law authorizes county boards of supervisors to divide their respective counties into suitable road districts, to change the boundaries thereof, and to create new districts. Existing law prohibits a county board of supervisors from including in the road district any city wherein street work and improvements are done by virtue of any law relating to street work and improvements within such city.

This bill would make technical, nonsubstantive changes to these provisions.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no.
State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1020 of the Streets and Highways Code
2 is amended to read:
3 1020. The boards of supervisors may divide their respective
4 counties into suitable road districts, may change the boundaries
5 thereof, and may create new districts. The board shall not include
6 in ~~such~~ *any* road district ~~any~~ *a* city wherein street work and
