An act to amend Section 69841 of the Government Code, relating to courts.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1008, as amended, Torres. Civil procedure: judges.

Existing law requires the clerk of the superior court to attend each session of the superior court in the county and upon the judges of the court in chambers when required. Existing law authorizes a judge to perform any act required or permitted to be performed by a clerk of the court.

This bill would provide that the above-described requirements of a court clerk are ~~not satisfied by a judge performing the duties of a clerk pursuant to~~ *required notwithstanding* the latter provision.
